Garment construction is a technical accomplishment that requires the knowledge and skills of basic sewing techniques— application of stitches, seams, darts, gathers, pleats and edge finishing, etc. Its appropriate application in garment construction is necessary for a good quality product. To improve student's knowledge of fashion and apparel designing, the Department of Family and Community Science conducted a value-added course on Fashion Designing.

The classes commenced on 1st November 2019. The class was given according to an approved syllabus with theory and practical sessions. During working days classes were conducted in the morning from 9 am to 10 am and from 9 am to 4 pm on Saturdays. The course beneficiaries was 2nd BSc. Family and Community Science students. Saturdays were utilised wee for the practical classes and theory sessions was given during working days.


















Conclusion
