Brief Bio: Dr. Thomas Mathew is working as a senior scientist in the Loker Hydrocarbon Research Institute, University of Southern California, Los Angeles. He received his Ph. D. from University of Kerala in 1989. The same year he moved to the Regional Research Laboratory, now National Institute for Interdisciplinary Science and Technology (CSIR-NIST), Thiruvananthapuram, where he worked in Photochemistry Research Unit till 1994. After receiving the Alexander von-Humboldt fellowship he spent 2 years in Albert-Ludwigs University, Freiburg, Germany. In 1996, he joined Loker Hydrocarbon Research Institute and he has been a leading member of the research team ever since. He is a fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry, London. He is also a visiting professor in many universities including the Chinese Academy of Science. He has published more than 150 papers in International Research Journals and also made more than 200 invited lectures.
