

Minutes of the Governing Council meeting of CMS College Kottayam (Autonomous) (GC/17.03) held at 9.00 am on 07th July 2017 in the IQAC Conference Hall, CMS College Kottayam.

After analyzing the result, the council noted that the pass percentage of various courses viz. BA History, BA Malayalam, B.Sc Family & Community Science, B.Sc Mathematics, BCA, BA Economics and B.Sc Botany is very low.

Chairman pointed out that the College has to strive hard to attain maximum result percentage under autonomous status. Remedial measures have to be initiated for effective teaching and for result improvement. The council recommended the Principal to constitute a special committee for analyzing results of both UG and PG programmes and also to suggest remedial measures.

After discussion, Chairman declared the result of 2016 Admission - UG IInd Semester examinations.

Other Matters.

1) UG Curriculum for 2017 Admission.

Principal reported that M.G University has revised the curriculum for UG programmes w.e.f 2017 and the revised curriculum was made available in M.G University website by 3rd week of July only.

It is decided to follow the curriculum introduced by Mahatma Gandhi University for UG programmes in 2017 for all UG programmes of CMS College for 2017 admissions.

2) AQAR Report

It is decided approve and forward the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2014 – 2015 to NAAC.
