b Program Specific Outcomes- Specific outcomes of BA History Course Program also to be prepared and incorporated in the curriculum

c.) Course Objectives-It has already be incorporated in the curriculum and shown at the beginning of each course syllabus as 'Aims and Objectives'

d) Course Outcomes -It is decided to include course outcomes specifically for each course syllabus

2 a) In order to cater local needs components like 'Benjamin Bailey and CMS Missionaries', 'Kuriakose Elias Chavara etc have already been incorporated in the course syllabus at Semester IV,Paper V, Making of Modern Kerala.

National, Regional and Global needs have already being incorporated in the curriculum through paper 8 ,India Nation in the Making (Semester 5),Paper 8 , Environmental studies and Human Rights in Historical outline

3. In order to develop employ entrepreneurship and skill development the BOS meeting decided to introduce specific 'Skill development Programmes in Communicative English and Computer Awareness'

4. a) Gender, b)Environment and Sustainability have already included in the curriculum c)It is decided to introduce a module on 'Human values and Professional Ethics ' in Paper 10 , Environmental Studies and Human Rights in Historical Outline

5 .Field Project has already being incorporated in the syllabus .In addition to that it is decided to engage students for field projects at the end of second and fourth Semesters for visiting local historical sites
