- 3. It was agreed to conduct a student induction programme for first-year undergraduate and postgraduate students.

- 6. It was determined to accelerate operations criterion-wise under the direction of Criteria Coordinators in order to prepare for the 4th cycle accreditation.

- 1. On September 10, 2021, Dr James C., the Controller of Examinations at Scott Christian College in Nagercoil, assisted in conducting an online preliminary external evaluation of the cumulative data collected for NAAC's 4th Cycle Accreditation.
- 2. The UG freshmen student induction programme was delivered online from September 22 to September 29. The program's chief resource person was Dr Mohan Thomas Pakalomattom. At the conclusion of the Induction Programme, a baseline assessment was done to determine the Advanced Learners and Slow Learners. The students' opinions on the induction programme were solicited.
- 3. On October 5 and 6, 2021, an external evaluation activity to verify professionalism in accreditation was organised. The resource person was Dr M.P. Rajan, a member of the NAAC Peer Team.

- 4. On October 11, 2021, IQAC supported the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Government College Kottayam to foster cooperative efforts between the English departments of both institutions.
- 5. On October 12, 2021, a parent-student awareness seminar on "Parenting the Youth" was held online.
- 6. From October 25 to October 27, 2021, an online student induction programme was held for PG newcomers. The resource person was Dr K. Jayakumar IAS, former chief secretary of the Kerala government and founding vice chancellor of Thunchath Ezhuthachan Malayalam University.

### Minutes/Resolutions:

- 1. It was decided to provide the faculty with financial aid so that, they may enrol in faculty development courses.
- 2. A SWOC analysis was decided to be carried out at the college.
- 3. It was stated that since students weren't attending college owing to the pandemic, personal counselling couldn't be provided to the pupils as in prior years. However, it was advised to conduct it online.

- On the advice of IQAC, the Internal Complaints Committee and Women Studies Centre arranged a symposium on crimes against women and children on October 28, 2021.
- 2. In order to make improvements, faculty members provided feedback on the success of the online courses. Teachers' opinions about the efficacy of online classes varied, according to the feedback analysis report.
- 3. IQAC took steps to improve on-campus online instruction. A list of the subjects covered in each online session was kept along with regular feedback from all teachers on how the classes were performed.
- 4. In order to facilitate an effective teaching-learning process, IQAC offered training for the faculty on how to use the Light Board.
- 5. QAC tracked the development of the procedure to ISO-certify the institution's Examination wing.

- 6. Faculty members whose PBAS documents were due for promotion were examined and recommended for advancement.
- 7. Faculty who requested financial assistance was provided with some financial help to take part in faculty development programmes.
- 8. An Administrative Training Programme was organized for the non-teaching staff on 'Hands-on Workshop in Front Office' on 20 November 2021.
- 9. With the assistance of outside specialists, the academic and administrative audit was carried out. The external auditors were Prof. (Dr) P G Sankaran, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Cochin University of Science & Technology (CUSAT), Cochin, Dr J Robert Victor Edward, Principal, Scott Christian College (Autonomous), Nagercoil, and Dr Rajan Varghese, Member Secretary, Kerala State Higher Education Council. Through the Principal, the reports were delivered to IQAC.

- 1. Student reviews of the faculty were gathered online through the college's web portal, and the principal received the analysis.
- Over the course of the current academic year, opinions on the syllabus were gathered from professors, alumni, students, and employers and examined. The appropriate study boards received the analytical report.

- 3. During the current academic year, multiple events were organized on research methodology, plagiarism, research writing and consultancy training for the benefit of the faculty and research scholars.
- 4. Funds were approved for faculty members who requested financial assistance in order to attend faculty development programmes.
- 5. Several Memoranda of Understanding (MoU) with institutions and organisations were completed to plan future joint actions.
- 6. During the current academic year, 96 value-added courses were conducted for the students for skill enhancement. Dr Anju Sosan George, Assistant Professor, Department of English coordinated the value-added courses.
- 7. IQAC conducted SWOC analysis as a measure of quality enhancement to identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges of the college.
