A video presentation of NCC Pledge by cadets was shown & a poster was made in association with NCC day.





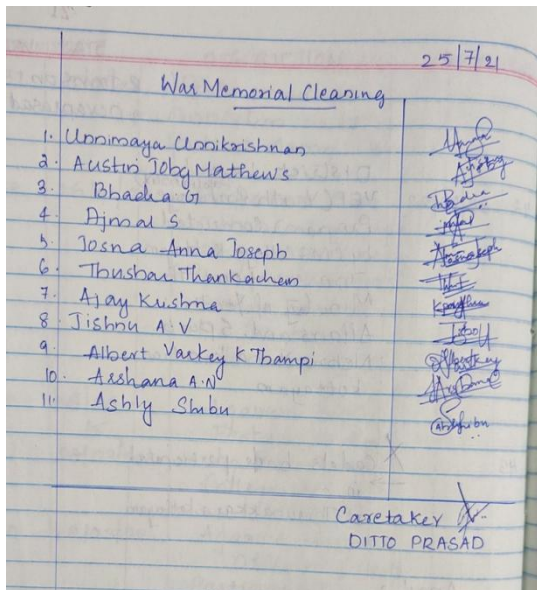
