WORLD AUTISM DAY

The volunteers were deeply moved by tears when they see the hungry eyes. Watching them fill their stomach was a very fulfilling moment for me.

The very first step to this academic year's agriculture was to make the soil fertile as the same land that we used the last year for agriculture and this reduces the fertility of the soil.
