
1. COVID 19 Awareness through Social Media


Be The CHANGE


3. 10th May 2020


International Nurses Day Celebration






World Day Against Child labour

A Google meet was also organised and our volunteers interacted to each on the topic of quitting plastic bags. This session had created awareness among volunteers to promote the use of Paper bags.






World Population Day Easy to Add Difficult to Maintain Let's not burden our Home.


increase in the world population and the importance of reproductive health.

Our unit had also conducted Essay writing competition and Poster making competition on the topic "Covid-19 and Population" and the winners were also announced.










Paper bag Day


15.26th July 2020

Karipur Plane Crash Sharing of information.

An Air India Express flight crashed at Karipur airport around 7.45 p.m. on August 7. The flight carrying 191 passengers crashed after overshooting the runway. 174 passengers, 10 Infants, 2 Pilots, and 5 cabin crew were on board the aircraft. The Air India Express flight was travelling from Dubai to Calicut. According to airport sources, the flight skidded off the rain-soaked tabletop runway while landing. About 20 people were killed including Capt. Deepak V Sathe and 173 others were injured.



Plogging Run & Gandhi Jayanti celebration





environment a better place to live in.








October 2-Gandhi Jayanthi





27.4th October 2020


Webinar on Wildlife Conservation and Photography.

wildlife photography, who is one of the founders of a photography expedition company called Expanded Expedition.



At the same time, it explains the things that need to be taken care of to attract butterflies and about how plants should be grown in the garden scientifically and simply.




International Volunteer Day

societies during this crisis, we will reach to all nooks of the globe with the message "Together We Can Through Volunteering", the theme of 2020 International Volunteer Day.



Election Awareness Video






New Voters Enrollment Training

NSS unit CMS College attended the training program conducted by the Kottayam Thaluk Election Control Wing for getting involved in the pre-election procedure of enrolling new Voters into the Voters list. Under the guidance of Tahasildar and Electoral Registration officer (ERO), 20 of our volunteers and programme officers actively participated in the training and ensured their attention and commitment in the enrollment procedures.

On 21st of December at 2pm a training session was conducted for all Colleges under Kottayam Thaluk. We expressed our pleasure in doing such a service and exclusively for NSS Volunteer of CMS College a session was conducted on 22nd of December. This training program was conducted to ensure the 100% Enrollment of new voters from the constituencies Puthupally, Kottayam and Ettumanoor respectively. Volunteers got training for Registration of new elector, Registration of overseas elector, Deletions or objections in Electoral roll, Correction of entries, Transposition within AC, Migration to another AC, etc.

The main focus was on the fresh inclusion of new Voters into the list. Our unit successfully completed more than 100 new enrollments. We know that NSS is a channel which is interconnected, we have Volunteers from almost all districts of Kerala and we used this resource of volunteer in the new enrollment process so that we got new enrollment applications from many areas.

7-Day Special Camp for First year Volunteers



The National Service Scheme Unit of CMS College Kottayam, organized a 7 day special online camp for the 1st year volunteers from December 22, 2020 to December 28, 2020. The 7-day online special camp was entitled, 'അതിജിവനം 2020' as we conducted a camp amidst of the Covid-19 pandemic. Conducting an online camp was a fresh and uncertain idea for the organizers, the virtual camp was conducted on Zoom Cloud Meetings, which owned the maximum beneficial facilities. While the Covid-19 pandemic restricted us from conducting a residential camp, we were able to complete the 7-day online special camp triumphantly.

Under the auspicious guidance of National Service Scheme unit of CMS college Kottayam, the virtual camp of 2020-21 academic year started at 4 p.m on 22nd December 2020 with the NSS anthem. The presidential address of Dr. Varghese C Joshua, the principal of CMS College Kottayam was followed by a welcome speech of Prof. Dr. Amrutha Rinu Abraham, the programme officer of NSS, CMS college. The seven-day special camp was inaugurated by Dr. Rekha Raj, NSS Programme coordinator of MG University and Assistant Professor of School of Gandhian Thought and Development studies.

All sessions were strict and time bounded starting with the yoga session at 7:30 a.m which was led by a 1st-year volunteer, Miss. Aleena Binu of Botany department, CMS College, followed by fieldwork at 10:30 a.m and then Afternoon sessions with interactive classes on different topics (An Awareness/ Skill Development sessions) from 3 p.m, ending with the cultural program session at 7:00 p.m. Hundred volunteers of the first year were divided into five groups for the better participation of each

volunteer in the activities. Different committees like report committee, magazine committee, Program committee, cultural committee and media committee were arranged to make sure the participation and capability of each volunteer. The cultural activities and programs on each day helped NSS volunteers to express and explore their hidden talents even through an online platform. Games, quizzes, news and trolls made the program astounding.

The seven day special camp started everyday with a healthy and refreshing yoga session. Each one of the first year NSS volunteers started their day with a bright and light yoga class which starts at 7.30 AM daily. It was conducted by one of the first year NSS volunteers, Miss. Aleena Binu of Botany department, CMS College. Resource Person from Volunteers is one of the ideas which NSS Unit of CMS College Kottayam promotes.

National Service Scheme helps the volunteers to become a better social being. In this scenario of Covid-19 pandemic, the field work was a challenge in NSS virtual camp. The time scheduled for field work was from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm and all the volunteers worked at their home according to tasks for a minimum of one and a half hours. To upload the photographs of the finished works, a google form was provided each day. The volunteers punctually uploaded the photos before 3:00 pm. Thus the field works of NSS virtual camp 2020 was done effectively. Cleaning activities, creation of vertical garden and kitchen garden, online surveys related to covid-19, awareness classes were some of the major activities conducted for the fulfilment of the duty as a NSS volunteer. The field work for day 2 of NSS camp was given to ensure the active participation

of the volunteers in cleaning activities. Plastic and e-waste management is a challenge we are facing these days. In order to manage these wastes without any harm the method of recycling can be applied. Keeping this as a tool, the field work for day 3 of NSS virtual camp was given to the volunteers. The task was to collect plastic bottles and reuse it to make vertical garden. The importance of a kitchen garden is great and manifold. The fieldwork for day 4 of the seven-day virtual camp was to create a kitchen garden in our home.

The Seven Day special camp started with an ice breaking session by Mr. Tomjith Makrose (Former NSS volunteer and Personality development trainer). The volunteers also had classes on personality development on different topics such as 'Movie and Community' by Dr.Sudheesh K.V.(Assistant Professor in St Thomas College, Kozhencherry), class on Personality development by Mr. Adoney T.John (Research Scholar at Maharajas College, Kochi), 'Rising from the Ashes' by Mr. Anish Mohan Kottayam, (Personality Transformation Coach and National Coordinator IPCAI), 'NSS volunteers as the providers and receivers of psycho-social support in the context of covid-19 pandemic' by Dr.Sudheeran T.S (Psychiatric Social worker, District hospital, Kottayam) and a Talk by Sri. G.P.Sajith Babu (Regional Director, NSS-Kerala, Lakshadweep) 'Community development through Darshanam' handled by Adv.Geetha Sarasakshan (Program Coordinator, Darshanam), and a talk by Sri. . FAZIL E. (Principal, MMOHSS, Parayapalli) and Dr. Thomas Abraham (International facilitator, Theme Centred Interactions And Former Programme Co-ordinator of NSS MG University). Each of these classes helped the volunteers to develop their personality and to understand their duties towards the community. The classes also made the volunteers believe in themselves and to have the confidence to face the challenges and consequences that come across life.

The 5th day of the virtual camp entrusted a survey as the field work for the day, Social Health Survey Regarding Covid 19. Each volunteer surveyed a minimum of 10 households each, which brought a total of more than 1000 households from various districts of Kerala. A Google form was given to collect the information, which had questions majorly from the context of Covid-19 pandemic. We were successfully able to collect information from 10 districts of Kerala, in which we got most from Kottayam district and then Thiruvananthapuram, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Wayanad, Kollam, Idukki, Palakkad, Malappuram and Kozhikkode. Personal details of the family members were asked, including name, occupation, Covid-19 cases and death, the number of people who got new jobs and lost jobs, working outside Kerala and India, the number of members who were a part of Sannadhasena of the government were noted. The Source of drinking water and the method of disposal of plastic wastes was noted. Number of fruit trees and domestic animals in the house were also taken. It was found that majority of the people are strictly following the Covid 19 protocols in their daily life. No reports of death were found. Only a small fraction of people were infected with Covid-19. Similarly, only a small percent of people lost their jobs. Among the 1000 households, 18 Sannadhasena volunteers were found. Majority of people used well as the source of drinking water. Plastic wastes were mostly collected and disposed by the Panchayat or Municipality of the area. Only a very few houses reported burning as the method for disposing plastic. After conducting the survey Volunteers

consolidated the data collected from the survey into a single Survey Report.

The cultural programs and news reports were the most awaiting programs of the seven-day virtual camp, programs for each day started at 7 pm. All the volunteers showed their keen interest for the programs to be held on each day. Everyone was able to present a variety of innovative programs within a short period. The news report was another session held after the cultural programs. They created trolls, memes, related to the recently occurred incidents of the camp.

The valedictory function of the 7 Day virtual camp was conducted on 28th December 2020. The chief guest and Keynote speaker on the event was the most respected Teeka Ram Meena IAS, the Chief Electoral Officer of Kerala. The theme of the session was about the participation of youth for a healthy and vibrant democracy. His lively class was followed by a camp overview report by Mr. Sijin M.George, Volunteer Secretary of NSS unit. The 7 Day virtual camp came to a spirited end by the


Republic Day







CHILD CARE PROJECT






and the public to eradicate drug abuse.

National Doctors' Day




6. 28th July 2020




7. 6th August 2020




8. 9th August 2020

Remembering Nagasaki Day.






11.16th September 2020



"Bring a life back to power. Make blood donation your responsibility."


Blood donation, a noble and selfless act. A single blood donation can save up to 3 lives. But a lot of people are hesitant about donating blood due to various reasons.

LONG TERM PROJECTS

BRIDGE PROJECT

The BRIDGE is basically a Financial assistance Scheme for Students organized by the NSS unit of CMS College. This project was initiated to provide financial assistance to students who are financially backward but excellent in their studies from the schools of different districts in Kerala. Financial assistance for the BRIDGE project is received from the well-wishers and delivered to the deserving students and the project is to be continued.

On 15th September 2020, a total of Forty-five thousand rupees (₹ 45,000) were given to four students of Government High School, Palissery. On 20th October 2020, a total of Twenty thousand rupees (₹ 20,000) were given to two students of CMS High School, Kottayam. On 2nd November 2020, a total of Fifty thousand rupees (₹ 50,000) were given to four students of Govt.HSS Chathamattom and one student of C.M.S.U.P. School Chelakomb.

As part of the BRIDGE project we took an initiative to collect a sum of Rupees Twenty Five thousand from our well-wishers for Ms. Sanika, our own college student for her educational needs. Prof. Dr. Varghese C Joshua, Principal of CMS College handed over ₹ 1 Lakh to Ms. Sanika, of 3rd DC Zoology, CMS College. This amount was jointly collected by the Department of Zoology CMS College, FOCCUS & NSS Unit CMS College.

On 31st March 2020, as part of the BRIDGE project of NSS Unit CMS College Kottayam, one time scholarship amount of 1500 was handed over to 8 students of Olasha Government H S for blind school. The program was oraganized in association with the ഐർദ്രത fellowship.

SAMRUDHI PROJECT

Samrudhi (mga) is a project organized by NSS Unit of CMS college, in collaboration with the University of Agriculture, to bring people closer to agriculture by creating a friendly attitude towards it and to educate them on various levels of agriculture. Based on the project we have conducted webinars in association with Mathrubhumi SEED and Kerala Agricultural University with an aim to provide information and to clarify doubts of people who had intrest in agriculture.

A State webinar was conducted on the topic " ശീതകാല പച്ചക്കറി കൃഷി: അറിയേണ്ടതെല്ലാം. " The webinar session was inaugurated by Shri. Thiruvanchoor Radhakrishnan MLA and the Presidential address was delivered by Dr. Varghese C Joshua, Principal of CMS College Kottayam.

In order to make people aware of the importance of leafy garden, NSS Unit CMS College organized a webinar on the topic 'Leafy garden to ensure nutrition' lead by Dr Jisha A Prabha, (Assistant Professor, ICAR Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Kerala Agricultural University, Kottayam) on January 3rd 2020. Green leafy vegetables are vital for growth and good

health as they contain all important nutrients. It is essential for the development of a healthy community with good nutrition.

KAITHANGU- Sub Project of Samrudhi.

Kaithangu is a project associated with the Samrudhi project initiated by the NSS Unit of CMS College. On 20 March 2021, at 3 pm the inauguration of (больтом) Kaithangu project was done by the Principal of CMS College Kottayam, Dr Varghese C Joshua.

The main objective of the scheme was to distribute hens to the poor and needy housewives. In the first phase, one hundred hens were distributed to twenty housewives. The main purpose of the project was to provide a way for the poor housewives in the society to earn an income of their own.

"ONE DAY ONE RUPEE CHALLENGE"

"One Day One Rupee Challenge" (ഒരു ദിനം ഒരു രൂപ പദ്ധതി) is a project started by the NSS unit of CMS College Kottayam with an objective of helping children with disabilities and their families who are facing financial difficulties. The amount for the One Day One Rupee Challenge was jointly collected by the first and second year NSS volunteers of CMS College.

As a part of the first phase of aid distribution kits were donated to families of ten differently abled students of 'JYOTHIS SCHOOL FOR

DIFFERENTLY ABLED'. The given kits contained food items, clothes and some other necessary items to the families. And in the next phase Special study materials were distributed to differently abled students at the KOTTAYAM AUTISM CENTRE.

CHILD CARE

'Child Care' is a project initiated under the leadership of NSS unit of CMS College in order to help the needy and poor children. The aim of this project was to provide medical assistance to children, distribute essential items, and to provide learning materials etc.

As part of the first phase of the project, 100 towels were donated to new born babies at the Medical College Children's Hospital, Kottayam on 31st March 2021. These towels will be provided free of cost to the new born babies of the poor parents who came to the INSTITUTE OF CHILD HEALTH.

CONCLUSION

The National Service Scheme Unit of CMS College had conducted its activities for the 2020-2021 academic year where in midst of the covid-19 pandemic that spread terror around the world. Since the covid-19 pandemic had brought about several restrictions in conducting offline activities. However, we succeeded in using the innovative possibilities of online medium and completed about 77 activities, both online and offline.

The NSS Units have conducted many activities inside and outside the college campus. The activities started in the month of April 2020 with the Covid 19 awareness programs. The routine programmes consist of Orientation programs, Celebration of days like Environmental day, Yoga day, Teacher's day, Literacy day, Gandhi Jayanthi, NSS day, Independence Day, Republic Day and other Special activities, like Special Camp, awareness on health and hygiene, Medical camps etc.

About seventy-seven activities including five long term projects, online webinars, blood donation camps, covid 19 awareness activities, election awareness programs, Inter-collegiate and all Kerala competitions were also organized. Our unit also complected the selection procedures of new volunteers for the 2021-2022 academic year and also conducted an online virtual seven-day camp for them via Zoom cloud meetings.

The COVID 19 pandemic had brought about several changes in our lifestyles and the sincere dedication of each volunteers is remarkable in each activity. Being at different places in different situations, volunteers were able to participate in the activities. The activities of this academic year 2020-2021 succeeded in bringing the vision and aim behind the motto of the National Service Scheme to the volunteers.
