Dr. Mini Chacko, the Chairperson welcomed the members of the newly constituted Board of studies. She explained the process of the PG Curriculum revision that took place over the past one month. The ongoing syllabus of the M.G. University was adopted with the following changes based on the feedback from alumni of the past two PG batches and Experts from different universities:

- 1. The contents of the three elective courses of IV th semester was rearranged into 4 courses. This was done to follow a unified pattern in all the PG courses of the College. The fourth course was titled Applied Biotechnology and Bioethics.
- 2. A module on BioNanotechnology was also added in the syllabus to cater to the real time requirements of the Biotechnology course

- 3. All the courses were rearranged to 5 modules each, so as to follow a unified pattern in all the PG courses of the College.
- 4. Programme Specific Outcomes (PSO's) of Botany were defined based on the PG Programme Outcomes (PO's) of the College. Following this, the Course Outcomes (CO's) of all the PG Botany courses were mapped. Model question papers of both Theory and Practical courses and their Blueprints were also prepared.

Approval of the Revised M.Sc. Botany Syllabus

The revised PG Botany Syllabus was presented before the newly constituted Board of studies of Botany. The Board approved the Syllabus with the following recommendations

- 1. The Latest references of books and websites to be incorporated in the syllabus
- 2. A mention of the APG system of classification to be included in the taxonomy course
- 3. Morphology to be placed first, in the same unit, before taxonomy.
- 4. More software references can be included in Biostatistics.
- 5. The references need to be arranged in a proper format
- 6. Induction of polyploidy by colchicine treatment to be included along with Mutation Breeding.
