The Chairman declared the result of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester UG examinations (2017 admission).

After analyzing the result the council pointed out that although there is an improvement in the percentages of B.Sc Family & Community Science, BA History and BA Malayalam in the third semester when compared to the First and second semesters, the low average is a matter of concern. The council suggested that remedial action be taken in this regard.

**Agenda: Item 2 – Commencement of Distance Education under M.G University.**

Vice Principal reported that, CMS College Kottayam has been identified as a centre for distance education by M.G University. The details will be intimated subsequently.

**Agenda: Item 3 – ISO Certification of examination wing.**

Vice Principal reported that, the proposal for ISO certification was put forward by the Controller of Examinations Dr. Tomy Mathew. The COE apprised about the significance of ISO certification for the College, stating that efficiency and quality in the examination function can be ensured by systemizing all the function and procedures relating to examination. He added that it will be an added advantage for the College in the next NAAC accreditation. It was also pointed out that since going for ISO certification for the entire College is a difficult task, for a start the certification can done for Examination wing.

After discussion, it is decided to go for ISO certification of the Examination wing.

**Agenda: Item 4 – Other matters.**

**Appointment of external auditor for special grants to college from Govt. / Semi Govt. bodies**

Rev. Jacob George reported that an external auditor be appointed for special grants to college from Govt. / Semi Govt. bodies, since the present auditor has completed five years and still continuing. Achen also suggested the name of K. Balaji, Chartered Accountant, Rangamani Associates, Kottayam.

Rev. Thomas Paikad pointed out that, as per the rules of CSITA all accounts under an institution is to be audited by a single auditor and at the end of the financial year all accounts are to be consolidated by the auditor, to be submitted to Diocese of Madhya Kerala.

After discussion, it was suggested that the decision be taken based on the auditor's confirmation to deliver good and timely service to the College.
