Extension of Autonomy

The Principal reported that the Autonomy extension report was prepared in the prescribed format, included in the UGC Autonomous guidelines, and was submitted to the UGC through Mahatma Gandhi University.

Annual Report of e-governance

The annual reports of the e-governance for the academic year 2021-22 was submitted before the Governing Council for approval.

NAAC Accreditation Updates

The Principal reported that the IIQA and SSR submission process are in progress for this term's cycle. The details of the projects currently underway are as follows:

- The library is getting revamped into a world-class, fully-automated one-stop place for research and reference to enhance teaching and learning.
- Construction of toilets as NAAC reported requirement of new toilets on the campus. Some of the existing toilets have exceeded their useful life and require rehabilitation. This project will also rehabilitate these toilets to be PWD compliant and address accessibility issues.
- In an effort to provide accessibility to physically disabled students, ramps, accessible toilets, and well-kept pavements are getting constructed.
- Under the green campus initiative, this year's focus is on irrigation, waste management, dry leaf compost, and enhancement towards an environment-friendly campus.
- Classrooms are refurbished with cutting edge audio-visual and video-conferencing
- Re-tarring of internal campus roads.
- The estimated amount for these ongoing projects is Rs.1,80,00,000.

A considerable amount is also requested for meeting the miscellaneous expenses for the NAAC preparation and peer team visit.



Reporting about the current projects

In addition to the above-mentioned ongoing projects, there are a few other current projects the college is involved in. The high-tension power project of around Rs 70 lakhs is in its completion stage with only the paperwork left. The RUSA fund of Rs. 2 crores is utilised for the following projects:

- Educational theatre-completed
- Two-storeyed Physics department building- eighty per cent completed
- Roofing work of Math Block-completed
- Chemistry department extension- completed

The available fund did not match the construction expense, and the management contributed an amount of Rs.38 lakhs during the budget hiatus.

The aquarium construction and ornamental fisheries project is in progress under the supervision of the Zoology department.

The sculpture garden and relief sculpture unify campus aesthetics and value aligning them with the history of the college and the church. Thirty sculptors worked on the 5000 square feet campus wall to complete the project.

Towards sustainability, several solar projects are undertaken in carefully planned phases.

Out of the five projects, the first one is completed using the PTA fund. Tender called for the upcoming solar panels project of approximately 60 kW.

No matter rose from the floor.
