Agenda Item: 3

Member Secretary stated that by 2020's it is expected that the future higher education sector will go through considerable changes and look quite different in terms of the functions of higher education institutions, modes of teaching and learning, pedagogical approaches, student-teacher relationships and the role of teachers. It is the need of the hour to address such problems and to increase access to higher education. A recommendation to start Human Resource Development cell at our College for the professional and quality development of teaching and non-teaching staff was presented. After discussion, the Council approved the proposal and entrusted the Principal to make the required arrangements.

Agenda Item: 4**Re-Constitution of IQAC.**

Member Secretary reported that as per the guidelines of NAAC the tenure of present IQAC ended by 26th June 2020. Member Secretary pointed out that, by next year College is going for the next phase of accreditation by NAAC and the preparation work has already been started and progressing under the guidance of present IQAC. Admission for the academic year 2020 - 2021.

Dr. Soma Bandhopadhyay suggested that a mechanism should be evolved to see that those students who are admitted will not take admission in other institutions simultaneously.

Agenda Item 6:

Institution of new scholarship and other financial supports.

The Council decided to institute two major scholarships on merit cum means basis. The first one was 20 scholarships instituted by the CMS Alumni USA chapter of 20 scholarships and the second one was to enhance the Bicentenary Scholarship of Rs.15-20 Lakhs/annum through donations from well-wishers to 200 students by way of scholarship/fee reimbursement under merit cum means category.

Agenda Item: 7

Online Classes.

From June 1st 2020 onwards, CMS College is conducting online classes, using Google classrooms, ZOOM, Moodle and other E-learning platforms. Principal proudly announced that the college has developed an innovative Light board for making the online classes effective. It was developed by Dr. Vipin Ipe Thomas and Mr. Midhun R Mohan. The college has also supplied a Light board to the Kottayam Press Club. Several academic institutions are approaching CMS College for installing the Light boards, in their institutions. The Governing Board members unanimously appreciated the same.

Agenda Item: 8

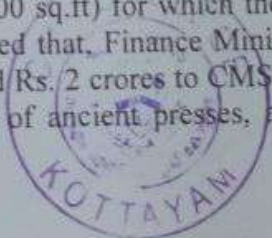
RUSA.

Member Secretary reported that, out of Rs. 35,00,000/- received by College, advance amount of Rs. 700000/- was transferred to District Nirmithi Kendra for starting renovation work of Language Lab and Maths building. It was also reported that the amount was transferred with the consent of Building committee, RUSA Board of Governors committee and RUSA Project monitoring committee. The Covid crisis has affected the pace of the renovation work. After discussion, the council approved the payment and entrusted Principal to make arrangements to monitor the progress of work as per DPR.

Agenda Item: 9

Historical Museum and Archives.

The site for the Historical Museum and Archives was approved by the Managing Council. The Team headed by Eugene Pandala identified six locations in the campus for the museum and archives out of which the location where the Sociology Department is placed at present was finalised for the Project. The team also prepared the Detailed Project Report for a three-storied building for the project. Procedures are underway to submit the DPR for the ground floor (8000 sq.ft) for which the Kerala State government has budgeted Rs.2 crores. Member Secretary reported that, Finance Minister, Dr. Thomas Issac has, in his Budget Speech State Budget 2020, announced Rs. 2 crores to CMS College Kottayam for the construction of Historical Museum for exhibition of ancient presses, archives,



manuscripts, palm leaves etc and for the upkeep of vast Archival collections in the college. It was also reported that the preparation of detailed plan and estimate is in progress.

After discussion, the council entrusted Principal to expedite the process and to submit the same to Government authority at the earliest.

Other matters.

- Member Secretary reported about vacancy arised in Finance Committee due to retirement of senior faculty member Sri. Abraham K Samuel who also served as HOD of Mathematics department.

- Member secretary reported that proposal has been submitted to the UGC for starting one year P.G Diploma course in Data Science under National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF).
- Rev Thomas Paikad suggested checking the feasibility of starting skill based courses making use of the Industrial school facility.
