Recommendation and Approval of the Curriculum for the following new programs.

I. B. Sc. Computer Science;

The Board of Studies for Computer Science CMS College Kottayam (Autonomous) held on 19 August 2022 recommended to start a new B. Sc. Computer Science w.e.f. 2023 admission. The Board of Studies also recommended to follow the existing curriculum of B. Sc. Computer Science of Mahatma Gandhi University. The Board of Studies also considered and approved the draft of the syllabus for B. Sc. Computer Science. The syllabus was presented to the Academic Council convened on 26 August 2022 and it was decided to forward the same for approval by the Governing Council.

After the discussion, it was decided to approve the curriculum and syllabi for B. Sc. Computer Science and forward the same to the Mahatma Gandhi University for the needed approval for implementation. It is decided to start the new program B. Sc. Computer Science from 2023 admission onwards, subject to the approval of the Mahatma Gandhi University.



2. M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics:

The Board of Studies for Home Science (Family and Community Science) of CMS College Kottayam (Autonomous) held on 23 August 2022 recommended to start a new M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics w.e.f. 2023 admission. The Board of Studies also recommended to follow the existing curriculum of M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics of Mahatma Gandhi University.

The Board of Studies also considered and approved the draft of the curriculum and syllabus for M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics. The syllabus for the programme was presented to the Academic Council convened on 26 August 2022 and it was decided to forward the same for approval by the Governing Council.

After the discussion, it was decided to approve the curriculum and syllabi for M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics and forward the same to the Mahatma Gandhi University for the needed approval for implementation. It is decided to start the new program M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics from 2023 admission onwards, subject to the approval of the Mahatma Gandhi University.

3. Recommendation and approval of the revision of the curriculum of the existing MA English Program.

The Board of Studies for English Language and Communicative Studies of CMS College Kottayam (Autonomous) considered and approved the draft of the revised syllabus for MA English in the Board meeting held on 24 August 2022. The Member Secretary informed that it was vital to revise the MA English because several of the topics were obsolete. Updates were, therefore, necessary, with a focus on ELT. The selection of elective courses takes into account regional, global, and employability considerations. The revised syllabus for the programme is in compliance with the course titles and the framework of the present syllabus for the MA English of Mahatma Gandhi University with the allowable revision of less than 20% in order to keep it equivalent to the MA English of the Mahatma Gandhi University. The revised syllabus was presented to the Academic Council convened on 26 August 2022 and it was decided to forward the same for approval by the Governing Council.

The Member Secretary reported that the curriculum and syllabus was conforming to the revised NAAC criterion on curricular aspects. As such the Graduate Programme Outcome (GPO) of the institution is mapped with the corresponding Programme Specific Outcomes (PSO), which was further mapped with the Course Outcomes (CO). The course contents in the syllabus are in line with the UGC Curriculum with the aim of attaining national and international standards. It was reported that the feedbacks were obtained from the stakeholders before the syllabus revision process. Due emphasis has been given to incorporate local contents, impart gender sensitivity, environmental consciousness and include skill oriented programmes while meeting the requirement at the national and global levels.

After the discussion, it was decided to approve the curriculum and syllabi for MA English Programme and forward the same to the Mahatma Gandhi University for the needed approval for implementation from 2023 admissions.
