Online Reporting

Step 3

- If you wish to continue with only one option, then accept that option and decline other options.
- If you wish to continue with two options then accept that two options and decline other options
- If you wish to continue with all three options the accept that three options and decline other options.
- If you do not wish to continue with the admission process then NO action is required.

Publication of first allotment list

Step 4

- First allotment list will be published based on the reported list of candidates.
- Higher option will be considered for preparing allotment list.

Document Submission at College

Step 5

- All relevant original documents shall be submitted at the College. Admission office will carefully verify the documents with the details furnished by the candidates in the application form.
- The documents will be kept in the college office.
