## Matters of Decision as per Agenda:

 Considering the pandemic and lockdown situations, it was decided to bring in modifications in the preparation of student projects and dissertations required to be prepared by Sem 4 MA and Sem 6 BA students.

- a. The number of pages for the core chapters are to be around 20 for UG and 30 for PG.
- b. Primary/ Secondary resources may depend more on materials available online.
- c. If the pandemic situation is not subsiding, students may be permitted to submit the dissertation document as softcopy, and without manuscript signatures. Submissions are to be through emails, send to the Supervisor, from where they are to be forwarded to the Heads of the Departments. Official email addresses of the teachers are to be used for this.
- 2. Teachers are to work in anticipation of regular classes to be affected for a while. Hence preparations are to be made to revisit the syllabi to evaluate possibilities of content delivery through online. Lectures and notes are to be prepared to suit this.
